PRIVACY NOTICE (ART. 13 GDPR 2016/679)

In accordance with Article 13 of the European Regulation 2016/679, we inform you of the following:

1. Data Controller:

The data controller is T.F.B S.r.l. (Tax ID: 04198150270) with registered office in Cannaregio 2497, Venice, acting in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

2. Type of personal data collected:

This document refers to the processing of the following personal data, which must be provided in order to participate in the "VINO VERO POSTCARD" CONTEST, excluded from the scope of Presidential Decree 430/2001 on prize competitions and prize operations, and of local prize draws, pursuant to Article 19, paragraph 4, of Law No. 449 of 27 December 1997.

6. Any information about the submitted photo (title, description, etc.).

3. The participant declares:

- a) to be the author and/or sole and legitimate owner of all copyrights and usage rights, including economic rights, of each submitted work, thus holding all reproduction rights;
- b) to have obtained, if applicable, all image rights and/or third-party rights regarding the content depicted;
- c) that nothing submitted is contrary to law or infringes intellectual property rights, moral rights, copyrights, personal data protection rights, publication rights, or any other rights, and that it complies with Italian copyright law (Law No. 633 of April 22, 1941) and its amendments;
- d) to be responsible for the content of the submitted works, holding the promoting company harmless from any claims and/or actions by third parties, and liable to compensate the promoting company for any damages, including legal expenses, even out of court, resulting from the violation of the above;
- e) to be aware that by submitting the photo, the participant grants the promoting company a free license to use, adapt, distribute, publish, and reproduce the work in any form or manner, without needing to credit the author each time.

4. Purpose of processing:

5. Processing methods:

Your data will be processed, respecting necessary confidentiality and security, as follows: collection through forms and photographic/video recordings, and subsequently used for purposes compatible with those stated above.

Processing may also involve electronic and automated tools.

6. Legal basis of processing:

The legal basis for processing your personal data is your freely given consent pursuant to Articles 6 and 7 of EU Regulation 2016/679.

7. Mandatory or optional nature of data provision and consequences of refusal:

Providing your data for promotional purposes, as outlined above, is optional and based on your explicit consent.

If you do not consent, your data cannot be processed for those purposes, and you will not be able to participate in the contest.

8. Disclosure of data to third parties:

Your personal data will be processed by the Data Controller, its appointed Data Processors, and personnel authorized for processing. It may be communicated to institutional bodies if requested.

Your data may be disclosed during inspections or audits (if requested) to the relevant regulatory authorities.

Your personal data will not be disclosed beyond the purposes outlined in point 4.

9. Data retention period:

Your personal data will be retained for as long as necessary to achieve the purposes stated in point 4.

10. Transfer of data to non-EU countries

The Data Controller may transfer your personal data to a third country or an international organization, in compliance with the guarantees provided by GDPR 679/2016.

11. Articles 15 and following of EU Regulation 2016/679 – Right to access personal data and other rights

The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning them exists, even if not yet recorded, and to receive such data in an intelligible form. The data subject has the right to be informed about the origin of the personal data, the purposes and methods of processing, the logic applied in case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic instruments, the identification details of the data controller, the data processor, and any designated representative pursuant to Article 5, paragraph 2; as well as the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who may become aware of it as designated representatives in the State's territory, as data processors or persons in charge of processing. The data subject has the right to obtain: the updating, rectification, which is, where interested, integration of the data; the deletion, anonymization or blocking of data processed in violation of the law, including data that does not need to be kept for the purposes for which it was collected or subsequently processed. The data subject also has the right to object, in whole or in part: for legitimate reasons, to the processing of personal data concerning them, even if relevant to the purpose of collection; to the processing of personal data for the purpose of sending advertising materials, direct sales, conducting market research, or commercial communication.

In particular, the data subject may, at any time, request from the Data Controller access to their personal data, as well as the rectification or erasure of such data, or the restriction of processing concerning them, or object to such processing. They also have the right to data portability.
